Important Information

Parking

We actively encourage our families to respect the road markings outside the school and <u>not</u> park on the zig zag and double yellow lines – safety of our children is our priority at Parclewis. However, as parking is outside the school premises we ask that parents take responsibility to keep children safe by ensuring that parking of vehicles is done in a sensible and respectable way.

Recently there have been several issues on the road outside schools' main entrance. Parking on the zigzags and double yellow lines is illegal and does mean that cars cannot pass one another resulting in much congestion and frustration at pick up time.

(Particularly during rainy weather).

Traffic officers are currently monitoring the situation to see if extra road markings etc. would help. In the meantime, regular checks by Parking Enforcement Officers are taking place and several fines have been issued.

Office Hours - the school office is staffed between 8.30am & 3.30pm.

ALL children must be supervised by an adult until 8.45am on all school yards

Parents are <u>not</u> permitted to park in the car park due to pupil safety <u>unless</u> exceptional circumstances have been authorised by school.

Important information – Parents/Guardians you could be eligible for.....

The majority of year groups in Primary school are now eligible for Universal free school meals (Year 5 & 6 will be eligible after the Easter holidays). Also many parents/guardians are entitled to School Essentials Grants once a year to aide with the cost of school uniform and equipment. In order to guarantee your entitlement to the grant you <u>MUST</u> be eligible for Free School Meals. Please see below the criteria and the link to apply.

You must apply for a Free School Meal even if you receive a Universal Free School Meal for your child as this will affect your possible entitlement to a School Essentials Grant

Please view the eligibility criteria before making your application below:

- Free school meals are available to children whose parents or guardians are currently receiving one of the following benefits:
- Child Tax Credit where total annual income is also less than £16,190
- Income Support (with responsibility for children)
- Income Based Job Seekers' Allowance (with responsibility for children)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of state Pension Credit
- Pupils who receive Income Support or incomebased Job Seekers' Allowance in their own right are also eligible to receive free school meals
- Employment Support Allowance (Income Related) (ESA(IR)).
- Universal Credit (if working, annualised net earnings must be £7,400 or lower)
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
