Welcome to Nursery! We are looking forward to a fun year ahead.

This term our topic will be Once Upon a Time and Culture and Traditions. The first topic supports children to develop a love of stories and reading. It encourages children to learn, retell and act out familiar and traditional tales including Cinderella, Goldilocks and The Gingerbread man.

During our second topic we will be exploring different cultures, traditions and celebrations that take place around the world during the autumn and winter seasons.

School times

Nursery children should arrive at school between 8.45-8.55am. Children should be collected from Nursery at 11.50am.



Please let us know in the morning if someone different will be collecting your child from school.

Clothing

Please make sure that all items worn or brought to school have you child's name on them. Please send your child to school in sensible coat and shoes - Velcro shoes are easiest for children at this age.

Snack

In the Foundation Phase we have healthy snack in class every day.

Snack must be paid at the beginning of each half term. Snack money should be brought in to school in an envelope with your child's name on. If we have not received money by Friday 13th

September then we will presume you are providing your own snack.

If your child brings their own snack in to school then please remember that this must be <u>fruit</u>, <u>vegetables or breadsticks</u> <u>only (no salted or cheese crackers please)</u>.

Please send a water bottle with your child's name on in to school with your child. This must contain water, not squash or juice. We will send water bottles home every day to be washed and refilled.

Supporting your child

Please encourage your child to be independent by washing their hands on their own, dressing and undressing themselves and teaching them how to put their own coat on.
