

Our topic

This term our topic is Sunshine and Sunflowers. This is a Science and Technology topic and explores Statement of What Matters 3 'The world around us is full of living things which depend on each other for survival'.

We will recognise that plants and animals are living things which grow at Progression Step 1. Read Write Inc sounds and words will continue to be sent home as we learn them. Please practise these at home with your child.




Reading books

Oxford Reading Tree books should be brought in to school with your child's reading record on their reading day. Please try to read with your child as often as you can.

As well as reading school books please encourage your child to read a variety of texts that they have at home.

As the days get warmer:

- Children should wear uniform that keeps their shoulders covered.
- Pupils should bring in a bottle of <u>water</u> to drink in class. This should be separate from their lunchbox and have their name on.
